"In the past, God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days, He has spoken to us by His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, and through whom also He made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being, sustaining all things by His powerful word. After He had provided purification for sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven." — Hebrews 1:1-3

- Key Takeaway: Jesus perfectly represents the essence of God.

5. Jesus Sustains All Things by His Powerful Word

- o Reference: Hebrews 1:3, Colossians 1:17
- Key Takeaway: The universe is upheld by the Word of Christ.

6. Jesus Made Purification for Sin

- o Reference: Hebrews 1:3, Colossians 1:19-20
- Key Takeaway: Jesus' sacrifice cleanses sin permanently.

7. Jesus Sat Down at the Right Hand of God

- o Reference: Hebrews 1:3, Colossians 1:18
- Key Takeaway: Jesus' work is finished; He reigns victorious.
